

ORDINANCE 473

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF CHAPTER 1 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 105 AND SECTION 18.08.200 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON REVISING THE DEFINITION OF FAMILY TO INCLUDE UP TO FIVE UNRELATED INDIVIDUALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WYOMING, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION I.

Section 4 of Chapter 1 of Town of Jackson Ordinance No. 105 and Section 18.08.200 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Jackson are hereby amended to read as follows:

18.08.200 Family.

The term family as used in this Code shall mean an individual, or two (2) or more persons related by blood, marriage, adoption, or similar legal relationship; or a group of not more than three (3) persons who need not be so related, plus domestic staff employed for services on the premises, living together as a single housekeeping unit in a one-family dwelling or in one unit of a two-family or multiple-family dwelling.

SECTION II.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause,, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

SECTION IV.


This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its publication following approval and adoption.
